It's that time of year to prepare for Victor's Gold Rush Days. We celebrate our heritage as the largest gold mining district in the US that is still producing gold and silver. The celebration will take place July 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Victor Gold Rush Days is sponsored through the efforts of the Gold Rush Planning Committee and the BPOE Elks #367 of Victor, Colorado.

This event takes place in historic Victor, CO. and vendors will be setting up on 3<sup>rd</sup> street. Since Victor's elevation is 9000 feet above sea level, we recommend all vendors be prepared for sudden weather and temperature changes.

Electricity is limited so it is recommended to bring your own generators. There is water nearby, bathrooms and portables. Possible lodging is available at the Victor Hotel and The Fortune Club (shared bath) at regular room rates. A **KOA** campground is available about five miles from Victor on County Road 81 if so desired. We will make every effort to accommodate everyone's needs, but must work within the confines of local ordinances and regulations. Your cooperation in this matter will be greatly appreciated.

Restrictions on merchandise and/or prizes are:

- No drug related or pornographic items.
- No knives, lighters or weapons of any kind to be sold to anyone under the age of 18.

It is our intention to produce an event that you –our vendors- will find exciting and profitable so that you will look forward to coming back to historic Victor, CO. We welcome your feedback and input.

Please make checks payable to Victor Gold Rush Days and send your payment with your application. Personal checks must clear two weeks before setup date so we urge you to send your applications back as soon as possible.

## **ARRIVAL AND CHECK-IN**

- Check-in, setup, vendor operating, teardown times and procedures will be provided to you at the time of vendor check-in.

## **FEES/CANCELLATIONS:**

- Price per space for the entire event is \$55.00. This fee includes City vendor permits. Electricity is limited and will be available on a first-come basis at \$25.00. **Non-profit vendors will not be charged any fees.**
- Full payment must accompany signed applications.
- Cancellations must be made in writing no later than 30 days prior to the event.

- Cancellations forfeit the City vendor fee.
- There is no refund or fee transfer for “no-shows”

**SPACE SPECIFICATIONS:**

- Applications are accepted and spaces assigned based on three criteria:
  - Date application was received
  - Previous history with Victor Events
  - The goal of diversity, variety and limited duplication.
- All space assignments are made at the discretion of the Event Manager.
- All spaces are 13'x13'. If you have displays, equipment or products that cannot fit in the confines of this space, you will need to purchase another space. Trashcan for customer use is the only exception.
- Do not use stakes or spikes to secure tents or equipment. You must use sandbags or concrete anchors, due to high wind possibilities.

**Services:**

- All vendors are responsible for cleaning their area of trash, leftovers, and waste.

**Security:**

- Limited security is provided. Vendors are responsible for securing all business and personal items during the event. All vendors are encouraged to report any suspicious behavior to event staff immediately.
- Vendors will be asked to provide contact information (cell phone#, where you are staying, etc.) during check-in. This will be used for emergency contact only.

**General Information:**

- You may check on Friday, July 15<sup>th</sup> between 1:00 and 5:00 pm at the Alta Vista Station – East Victor Ave. After check-in vendors can set up and remain open until 5:00 pm. On Saturday, vendors are required to stay open until 5:00 pm with the option of extending hours to 9:00 pm. On Sunday, teardown begins at 4:00 pm and must be completed by 6:00 pm.
- Pets must be caged or on a short leash away from public.
