ORDINANCE NO. 404

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE PROSCRIBING THE GENERAL OFFENSES IN THE CITY OF VICTOR AND SETTING THE PENALTIES THEREFOR

WHEREAS, the City of Victor is currently without an ordinance proscribing the general offenses and the penalties for violations of such offenses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to adopt such an ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTOR, COLORADO:


Section 1. The general offenses and penalties set forth in this ordinance are hereby adopted for the City of Victor. This ordinance shall be known as the City of Victor General Offenses Ordinance, and shall supercede and replace any prior ordinance or resolution in conflict therewith.

Section 2. Safety Clause. The City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that this ordinance is promulgated under the general police power of the City of Victor, that it is promulgated for the health, safety, and welfare of the public, and that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of health and safety and for the protection of public convenience and welfare. The City Council further determines that the ordinance bears a rational relation to the proper legislative object sought to be attained.

Section 3. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgment shall not affect application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after final publication.
