

**CITY COUNCIL OF THE

**ORDINANCE NO. 500**

**TITLE: AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THE SPECIFIED RADIUS OF THE ENTRYWAY TO PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN WHICH SMOKING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.**

WHEREAS, the recently enacted Colorado Clean Indoor Air Act, House Bill No. 06-1175 (the "Act"), prohibits smoking within the entryway of most public places; and

WHEREAS, the Act defines "entryway" as a "specified radius outside the doorway" and further states that the "specified radius shall be determined by the local authority or, if the local authority has not acted, the specified radius shall be fifteen feet for the area included within an entryway"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the "specified radius" should be less than fifteen feet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTOR, COLORADO:

Section 1. The "specified radius" of an entryway within which smoking will not be permitted pursuant to the Act shall be five (5) feet.

Section 2. Safety Clause. The City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that this Ordinance is promulgated under the general police power of the City of Victor, that it is promulgated for the health, safety, and welfare of the public, and that this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of health and safety and for the protection of public convenience and welfare. The City Council further determines that this Ordinance bears a rational relation to the proper legislative object sought to be attained.
