**GOAL:** IMPROVE THE CITY GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS TO DEVELOP AN EFFICIENT SERVICE DELIVERY SYSTEM

**OBJECTIVE:** Through the utilization of communication strategies, promote community trust and pride, and with technical assistance, improve government operations.

**ACTION TEMS:**

- Transition the city from a reactionary position to a proactive position to better manage the assets of the city now and in the future.
- Consider additional communication tools including an expanded web page, city blogs, citizen surveys, a suggestion box and town hall meetings.
- Explore the hiring of a city administrator.
- Update city policies and procedures to increase administrative efficiencies.
- Develop a personnel management system.
- Provide additional training opportunities to staff, boards and commissions.
- Utilize the Police Advisory Committee to help create a more sustainable police department.
- Pursue opportunities to improve communication between and among council/staff.
- Create/renew intergovernmental agreements to maximize resources in providing services to the community.
- Update land use regulations and planning documents.

**GOAL: BUILD THE CITY'S FISCAL HEALTH TO ACHIEVE SUSTAINABILITY**

**OBJECTIVE:** Maintain and improve City services through strategic planning and additional revenue streams.

**ACTION ITEMS:**

- Explore ways to reduce dependency on operational grants.
- Consider creation of an asset management plan.
- Dispose of surplus assets.
- Reduce City debt where appropriate.
- Develop policy on use of revenues from the sale of water to the mine.
- Utilize the Three Mile Plan to improve fiscal health.
- Consider the acquisition of additional water rights.
- Reduce the use of non-renewable resources and set a goal for renewable energy use.
- Explore the creation of a fire district.

**GOAL: DEVELOP A SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY BUILT UPON THE PIONEER SPIRIT OF VICTOR**

**OBJECTIVE:** Enhance and improve the quality of life for the entire community.

**ACTION ITEMS:**

- Access programs to further worker housing, senior housing and the weatherization of homes.
- Expand recreational opportunities available to the community.
- Develop an open space plan.
- Develop a bike path/pedestrian way plan. Enhance mobility and transportation.
- Start a community recycling program.

**GOAL: IMPROVE THE IMAGE OF THE CITY TO FOSTER AN ENVIRONMENT TO FURTHER ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITES**

**OBJECTIVE:** Maintain the City's cultural heritage while moving toward the future. Develop and implement plans to provide a more competitive and diverse economy.

**ACTION ITEMS:**

- Develop a Way Finding Plan.
- Create a beautification plan.
- Form an Economic Development Plan.
- Pursue opportunities to improve the telecom, gas, and electrical infrastructure.
- Update land use regulations to encourage mixed use development, cottage industries and light manufacturing.
- Enhance mobility and transportation.
- Explore inclusion into the enterprise zone.
- Conduct econ. assessments using State, Fed. or non profit rograms.
- Consider Economic Development incentives.
- Develop a parking plan.
